Role play on the concept of vedic, Budhist, Muslim and British education was done by B.Ed 1^{ST} year students. It as an innovative practice implemented under


Internal Quality Assurance Cell HPCE to acquaint the students with in depth knowledge of education system in all the above mentioned eras.

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
